The successful candidate will be someone with a proven track record of excellent outcomes at Key Stage 4, exceptional curriculum knowledge, a willingness to work flexibly to support the achievement of students, someone who consistently models outstanding practice and has students' wellbeing at the forefront of all that they do. This position would suit someone who has the ambition of progressing to Head of Department and beyond, within the next 2 years. We are committed to providing the appropriate training and experiences for the successful candidate to achieve this.

Mathematics is a leading department within the school and members of the team work closely to support a number of schools, both at the primary and secondary education level. With a robust pupil premium intervention team, slightly smaller class sizes and our links with the National Centre for Excellence in the Teaching of Mathematics (NCETM), pupil performance has been consistently excellent at both key stages for a number of years. In 2018, 72% attained at least a grade 4 at GCSE level, with 30% attaining at least a grade 7.

The school has become a PFEG Centre of Excellence in Financial Education due to the collaborative work led by members within the Mathematics Department, between all of the faculties within the school.

Department staff play a wider role in the school and community and have been instrumental with STEM visits and visitors, the School Fair, Ski Trip, Romsey Show, Enterprise Project, Duke of Edinburgh Award and our Romsey2Kenya project.

We will be strongly committed to your professional learning. As a member of the school staff you will have access to our staff benefits programme, which includes use of our nursery and you will also receive your own tablet device.
