

Deputy Curriculum Leader: Mathematics

The exact responsibilities will be negotiated with the successful candidate; however they are likely to include:

- Supporting the development and delivery of an outstanding curriculum area
- Assisting in the delivery of the Professional Development Programme to mathematics staff at The Romsey School and to the schools we outreach to as part of our Gateway Multi Academy Trust.
- Leading on the changes that need to be made to the key stage 4 programme of study, including assessment, in light of the changes to the National Curriculum and GCSE reform
- Supporting the Curriculum Leader in analysing progress and attainment data over key stage 4, to make data driven changes to curriculum design, pupil intervention and set changes
- The performance development of up to two members of the maths department
- Monitoring and evaluating the Mathematics Home-Learning Programme
- Assisting the Curriculum Leader in updating the departmental self-evaluation and department action plan, as appropriate, during the academic year
- Liaising with our Special Educational Needs Department
- Ensuring the Mathematics Department remains well-resourced with high quality resources and that all staff are utilising resources effectively
- Assisting the Curriculum Leader in devising and monitoring cover for absent colleagues
- Further developing our connections with STEM and financial industries
- Developing links with our local 6th Form Colleges and Universities, to ensure pupils and staff are well informed of mathematics provision post-16
- To be a mentor for ITT students

Gateway Multi Academy Trust (GMAT)

The school has been accepted for Multi Academy Trust status and we are due to have our first school joining us by the end of the academic year 2018-2019. As part of our bid we have formed a strategic alliance with The Halterworth Teaching Schools Alliance (Primary) and Barton Peveril College (6th Form) in order that we can support any phase of school. The Romsey School will be the lead secondary school in the newly formed trust.

We would hope that there will be opportunities to work across the trust as appropriate and when necessary although the post on offer is at The Romsey School. We believe this will provide further CPD opportunities for anyone working within the trust.
