

## **The Mathematics Department: Deputy Curriculum Leader: Mathematics (Main Scale/UPS plus TLR2b)**

The successful candidate will be responsible for the Assessment, Learning and Teaching in Mathematics over key stage 4. The Mathematics Department is very successful. We are looking for someone to contribute to this success and support the Head of Faculty in doing so; someone who will actively participate within the department and further enrich our pupils' experiences within mathematics. This position would suit someone who has the ambition of progressing to Head of Department and beyond within the next 2 years. The Mathematics Department at The Romsey School consists of ten specialist teachers and 4 specialist maths tutors. Maths is taught in a suite of rooms and is situated in the main block of the school overlooking Romsey Abbey.

Mathematics is a leading department within the school and members of the team work closely to support a number of schools, both at the primary and secondary education level. With a robust pupil premium intervention team, slightly smaller class sizes and our links with the National Centre for Excellence in the Teaching of Mathematics (NCETM), pupil performance has been consistently excellent at both key stages for a number of years. In 2018, 72% attained at least a grade 4 at GCSE level, with 30% attaining at least a grade 7.

All mathematics teachers have a balanced timetable, teaching the full range of ages and abilities. Pupils are taught in sets and composition of all sets is subject to continual review.

The department meets on a regular basis and all teachers contribute. The focus for faculty meetings is on the improvement of teaching, learning and assessment, and they often take the form of a workshop. There is also a mathematics staff room.

Department staff play a wider role in the school and community and have been instrumental with STEM visits and visitors, the School Fair, Ski Trip, Romsey Show, Enterprise Project, Duke of Edinburgh Award and our Romsey2Kenya project.
